

Bruce Kay Scholarship for Undergraduate Studies 2023 Guidelines

<u>Purpose</u>: The Richmond CPCU Society Chapter awards scholarships to undergraduate college students based on an expected interest in pursuing a career in the insurance and risk management industry. Consideration will be given based on academic and extracurricular achievements and application responses.

<u>Criteria</u>: Eligible students must be an undergraduate student enrolled in an accredited Virginia or North Carolina two or four-year college or university with an intent to enroll (or are currently enrolled) in a business degree program with an interest in pursuing a career in the insurance and risk management industry.

Students should submit the following to be considered:

- Resume
- Transcript (Official or Unofficial)
- Responses to the following short essay questions (250 words or less):
 - 1. What do you envision as your desired career in insurance and risk management?
 - 2. Insurance matters. How has insurance impacted your life?
 - 3. What is the value of an industry-recognized professional designation?
 - 4. Why should you be considered for this scholarship?

<u>Amount</u>: Each scholarship awarded will be up to \$3,000.00 to be paid in one payment. Funds will be dispersed to recipients via their selected university or college and are to be used for tuition, course materials, and room and board. This is a one-time scholarship award.

<u>Deadline</u>: The scholarship deadline is May 1, 2023. The deadline is the date after which applicants will no longer be accepted. Postmark will be used to determine mailed entries. Recipients will be notified by May 15, 2023, via email and recognized at a CPCU Chapter-sponsored event.
