

Mary Beth Scherer Scholarship for Professional Development Fall 2020 Guidelines

<u>Purpose</u>: The Richmond CPCU Society Chapter awards scholarships to professionals in the insurance and risk management industry. Consideration will be given based on lack of company financial support for continuing education through the Institutes, individual's dedication to the industry and application responses.

<u>Criteria</u>: Eligible professionals must be active in the insurance and risk management industry with an intent to complete the CPCU designation.

Students should submit the scholarship application as well as the following to be considered:

- Resume
- Letter of Recommendation from a Supervisor
- Responses to the following short essay questions (250 words or less):
 - 1. How has the insurance industry impacted your life?
 - 2. What are your career goals and how will the CPCU designation advance these goals?
 - 3. Why should you be considered for this scholarship?

<u>Amount</u>: Each scholarship awarded will paid in the form of a voucher valued at \$750. The voucher is to be used towards a Richmond CPCU Chapter class, Institutes' course materials, and/or exam when ordered through the Richmond Chapter. This scholarship is not renewable. Previous scholarship recipients cannot reapply.

<u>Deadline</u>: The application deadline is October 15, 2020. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. Postmark will be used to determine mailed entries. Recipients will be notified by November 16, 2020 via email and scholarships will be awarded at the 2021 RISC TRENDS conference.
